Risk Assessment

Policies

- The monitoring of all New dogs coming into the home boarding/day care environment and also doing a meet and greet with my dog.
- Questionnaire which will be filled out by the dog owners will cover the behaviour of the dog and this will be monitored daily and any changes in behaviour and/or behaviour indicative of suffering, stress, fear, aggression and anxiety will be recorded and acted upon.
- Questionnaire will be kept with a hard copy filed and photo copy kept on my computer.
- Feeding regime will be that the dogs will be fed according to their owners eg once or twice a day etc... and will be fed separate if required.
- The house will be cleaned everyday in particular the areas that the dogs are mostly in with disinfectant and the garden where the dogs will be going to the toilet will be cleaned up straight away and disposed of accordingly.
- If the dogs are required to be taken to the vets for any particular reason whilst in my care I have a van which has creates in the back for safe transportation of your dog.
- For the prevention of and control of the spread of disease I have three rooms available to keep the dog separate. All dog must be vaccinated in accordance with vets requirements and have regular flea and worming treatment with a suitable licensed product.
- In the unfortunate event of the death of your dog, Forget me Knot pet Crematorium will be notified to collect the animal to keep for your return.
- In the event of an escaped dog I would notify the owners and contact the Police and local vets to make sure they are aware to notify me. I would also put the information on social media.
- In the event of an emergency or loss of my licence I would use another local Dog Boarder to take in any animals I have.

- Emergency plan in case of fire or in case of breakdowns for essential heating ventilation or other emergencies - I have access to my Fathers home which I would use and also my local Vets which they have given me approval of to use as my emergency contact. I have a designated other person Stephen Stark who can cover in an emergency or absence of leave so that the dogs are never left alone.
- I have two walks which cover a minimum of 30 minutes to exercise the dogs and also have alternative forms of enrichment planned for dogs which cannot be exercised for veterinary reasons for the same periods of time which are find the treat etc.
- I have two secure physical barriers between any dog and any entrance/exit.
